4 - But I say, love your enemies! Pray for those who persecute you! Matthew 5:44 NLT


5 - Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

8 - For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision carries any weight - the only thing that matters is faith working through love. Galatians 5:6 NET

9 - Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" Matthew 22:37-39 NIV

18 - Love is patient.. 1 Corinthians 13:4 NIV


19 - ...love is kind. 1 Corinthians 13:4 NIV

25 - ...love rejoices with the truth. It always protects...1 Corinthians 13:6-7 NIV


26 - ...love always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. 1 Corinthians 13:7 NIV

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world should be saved through Him. He who believes in Him is not judged; he who does not believe has been judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. John 3:16-18 NASB

For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:6-8 NASB


But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved)... Ephesians 2:4-5 NASB

See how great a love the Father has bestowed upon us, that we should be called children of God; and such we are. 1 John 3:1a NASB

This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters. 1 John 3:16-17 NIV

Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us. 1 John 4:7-12 NIV
